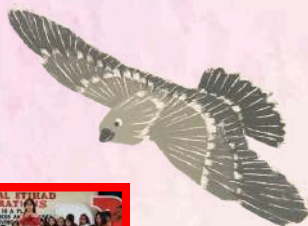
SustainEd: Shaping Sustainable Minds for a Greener Tomorrow

# A Day of Fun and Laughter: Children's Day Recap

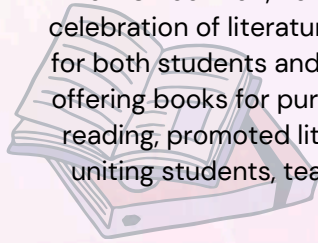

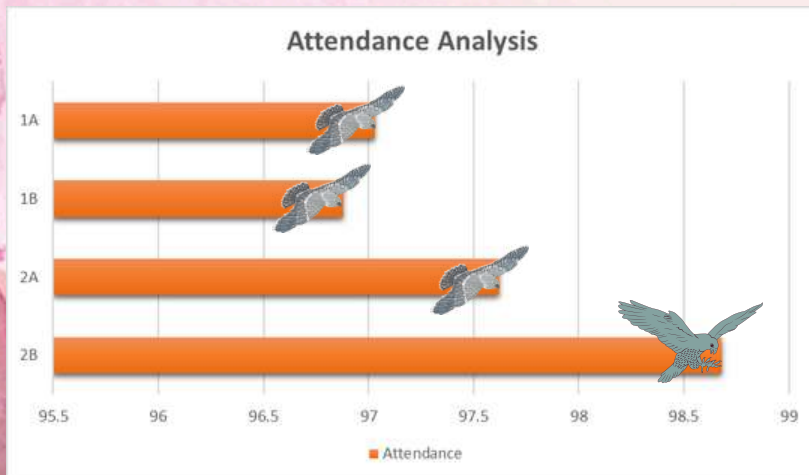
