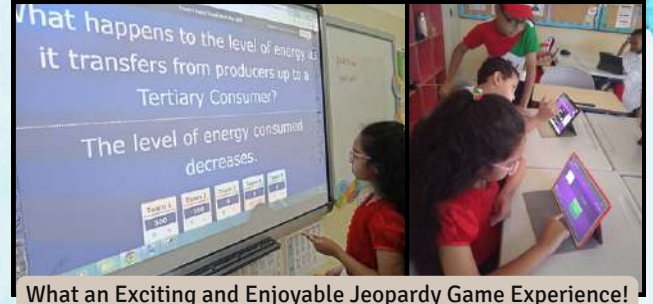

Paperless Day

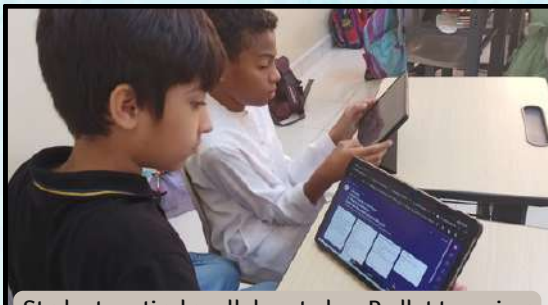
On this unique day, EIS urged students to bring just their digital devices, such as laptops or tablets, and to forgo traditional paper resources.

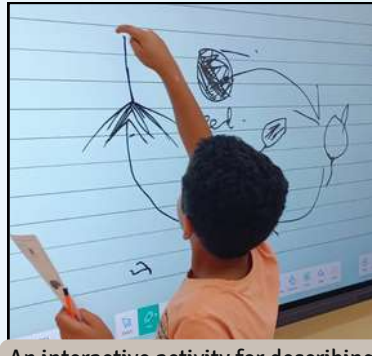

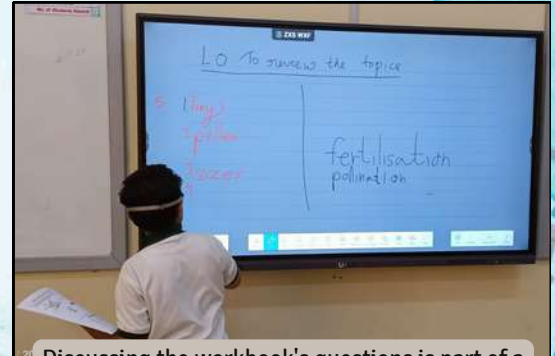
Locating UAE and Balad Sayt a mountain village tucked between the Western Hajar mountains in Oman in the world map.
