Our students brought Charlie Chaplin's timeless charm to life with a delightful dance full of smiles and laughter!

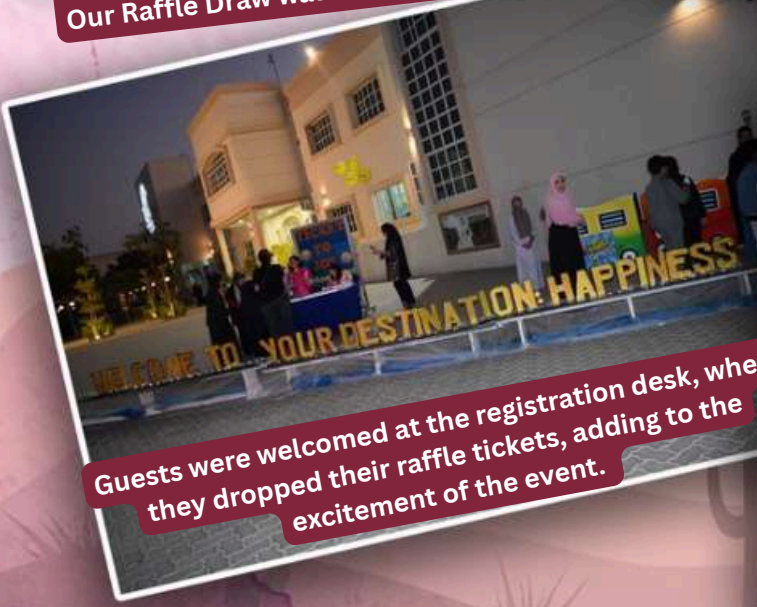


Colourful clowns, cheerful moves, and endless smiles!

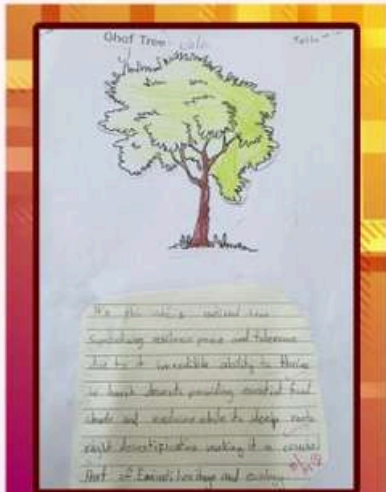


Differentiated Task to group Invertebrates
