Recyclables	Initiative Target
Paper	Newspapers, magazines, office paper, cardboard, junk mail, paper bags, books.
Plastic	Plastic bottles, food containers, plastic bags, rigid plastics, plastic utensils.
Aluminum Cans	Beverage cans, food cans, aluminum foil, trays

You are welcome to send these items to school with your child if you have them at home. **The deadline for collection is November 1, 2024.** We encourage you to consider sending these items to us instead of discarding them in the trash (please ensure to clean and send them).

Furthermore, we are excited to introduce a new initiative at Excel International School where students will engage in creative learning activities using recycled materials. To support this, we kindly request your assistance in collecting various recyclable items that can be repurposed as **manipulatives for our classroom projects.** 

We are looking for the following materials:

- Bottle caps (plastic or metal)

- Cardboard tubes (from paper towels or toilet paper)
- Small plastic containers or lids
