- **Term 3 Notebooks**
We kindly ask parents to send with their child a new set of notebooks for Term 3, encompassing English, Mathematics, Science, and Arabic Language, to school on Monday, 7th April 2025.
 - **Answer Scripts of Term 2 Summative Assessment** (Year 5/Grade 4 to Year 9/Grade 8 Students)
Teachers will be showing the students for review their Term 2 assessment papers from 7th to 8th April (Monday and Tuesday). We encourage our students to engage in thoughtful dialogue with their teachers regarding any questions or clarifications they may have. Additionally, Term 3 targets will also be discussed with them.
 - **Open House**
The Open House event will take place on **Friday, April 11, 2025, from 6 PM to 9 PM**. Parents and guardians will receive their child's **Term 2 report card in a digital format** (soft copy), provided that all outstanding school fees up to March 2025 are settled. If you prefer, a hard copy of the report card can be requested from the class teacher. Additionally, the same will be uploaded to Education at a later time.
