- **Term 2 Report Cards**

The Term 2 report cards will be available for viewing on Eduration as soon as they are uploaded to eSIS TAMM, expected within this week. Please note that no changes will be made after this process. Also, families with unpaid fee balances until March 2025 will not have access to report cards on the platform.

- **Transition to Eduration Platform – Our New Learning Management System**

We are happy to announce a **VIRTUAL** training session for parents about the Eduration App. This session will help you learn how to use the key features of the program. We will share the schedule for this meeting soon.

- **Online Class Tasks (Activities)**

Students enrolled in Grades 7 and 8 are expected to bring their devices to school **ONCE A WEEK** to engage in online tasks and research activities. This decision has been made in response to reports indicating that some students have been using their devices during breaks and after school. The intended use of devices is solely supervised by teachers, ensuring that students remain focused during instructional time while minimizing extended screen exposure. Any student found using these devices outside of designated class periods will have their devices confiscated, and parents will be duly notified. We appreciate your support in reinforcing this message with your children.

- **Caution Regarding Bhanzu's Fraudulent Math Online Classes Subscription**

We wish to alert our parents to refrain from engaging with a company named Bhanzu, which claims to provide paid math coaching for children. This company has been making unsolicited calls to parents, using credible information to appear legitimate and claim partnerships with schools in the UAE. We thank the attentive parent who brought this issue to our attention.

**Please note that Excel International School is not connected to Bhanzu for any online math coaching services.** We will always keep parent community informed about approved platforms or online resources that the school has recommended as additional educational tools.
