EIS recognises the enriching educational value of engaging and captivating school trips.

A visit to the **Al Ain Oasis**, a *UNESCO Cultural Site*, will allow our Grade 1 students to explore the historic falaj system. This system provides an interesting look into the innovative water solutions of the past. The 3,000-year-old channels, created by the Bedouins, are still in use today. They transport water from distant mountains to support the thriving greenery of the oasis.

**The students of Grade 1 A & B will tour Al Ain Oasis on September 30, 2024 (Monday).** A signed parent consent form is required for a child to participate in this endeavour.

For participating students, be advised of the following:

- You should come to school in your **PE uniform**.
- The school will provide transportation to and from Al Ain Oasis.
- A packed lunch and water bottle.
- A cap or hat for protection.
