To enter the competition, students must send a letter to someone significant about the theme 'Imagine'. The letter-writing competition is available to students aged 8 to 18.

• Addressing Parent Feedback on Rayah

We appreciate the parents who have downloaded and started using ADEK's Rayah, the parent app.

ADEK has reviewed the feedback and would want to clarify two key areas:

The first concern expressed by parents is that their children do not show up on Rayah. This occurs when both parents are not registered on eSIS. We respectfully suggest that our parents visit the school reception to register the profiles of both parents/legal guardians on eSIS on-site to resolve the issue. The UAE Pass app must be active to authenticate the process.

The second concern is about the Standardised Benchmark Assessment (SBA) and its interpretation. Since AY 2020/21, when SBA became mandatory, ADEK has offered schools webinars, compliance training, and assistance in properly implementing the SBA. The SBA's interpretation of Rayah has caused some misunderstanding. ADEK will send a correspondence next week with a detailed explanation of this.

Rayah's upcoming features will assist schools improve communication and interaction with parents about their children's education.
